Allur C.D. Block lies in the north-eastern part of Nellore district. The Block is located at a distance of 32 kms. from district headquarters (Nellore). There are 15 villages in the block with the total population of 52,990 persons. Area of the C.D. Block is 177.74 sq. kms. It is bounded in the north by Mandal Bogole, in the south by Mandals Kodavalur and Vidavalur, in the east by the Bay of Bengal and Vidavalur Mandal, and in the west by Mandals Dagadathi and Kodavalur.
