Barnala C.D. Block lies in the western part of Sangrur district. It is a part of Barnala tehsil. The Block is located at a distance of 37 kms. from district headquarters (Sangrur). There are 51 villages in the block with the total population of 167613 persons. Area of the C.D. Block is 658.26 sq. km. It is bounded by CD Block Mahal kalan on north, district Mansa and CD Block Sangrur on south, CD Blocks Sherpur and Dhuri on east, CD Block Sehna and district Bathinda on west, and CD Block Malerkotla-II north-east.
