Antagarh C.D. Block lies in the south central part  
of Kanker district. It is a part of Antagarh tehsil.  
The Block is located at a distance of (NA) kms. from

65,756 persons. Area of the C.D. Block is 704.70 sq.  
km. It is bounded by tahsils Bhanupratappur and
