HAISAR BAZAR(Uttar Pradesh page.649)

Haisar Bazar C.D. Block lies in the southern part of Kabir Nagar district. It is a part of Ghanghata tehsil. The Block is located at a distance of (NA) kms. from district headquarters (Khalilabad). There are 295 villages in the block with the total population of 225,265 persons. Area of the C.D. Block is 254.04 sq. km. It is bounded by vikas khand Nath Nagar on north, district Ambedkar Nagar on south, district Gorakhpur on east and south-east, and vikas khand Kudraha on west.
