Killiyur C.D. Block lies in the southern part of Kanniyakumari district. It is a part of Vilavancode taluk. The Block is located at a distance of XXX kms. from district headquarters (Nagarkoil). There are 05 villages in the block with the total population of 50,936 persons. Area of the C.D. Block is 63.80 sq. kms. It is bounded in the north by CD Block Thakkalay, in the south by the CD Block Kurunthancode, in the east by CD Blocks Kurunthancode and Thakkalay, and in the west by CD Block Munchira.
