

## A.KONDURU

A. Konduru C.D. Block lies in the northern part of Krishna district. The Block is located at a distance of 105 kms. from district headquarters (Machilipatnam). There are 13 villages in the block with the total population of 44,930 persons. Area of the C.D. Block is 207.61 sq. kms. It is bounded in the north by Mandal Tiruvuru, in the south by Mandals Mylavaram and Reddigu dem, in the east by Mandals Vissannapet and Reddigudem, and in the west by Mandals Gampalegudem and Mylavaram.

There are 22 villages in the block with the total population of 57,313 persons. Area of the C.D. Block is 372.42 sq. kms. It is bounded by Nalgonda district on northern and eastern side, Uppunthala Mandal on north western side, Balmoor Mandal on west, and Amrabad Mandal on south.
