

AGAMONI

Agamoni C.D. Block lies in the north-western part of Dhubri district. It is a part of Agamoni Revenue Circle. The Block is located at a distance of (NA) kms. from district headquarters (Dhubri). There are 67 villages in the block with the total population of 121134 persons. Area of the C.D. Block is 175.75 sq. km. It is bounded by district Kokrajhar on north, by cd block Golokganj on south-east, by cd block Rupsi on south, the Nation of Bangladesh on west, and the state of west Bengal borders on north-west.
