Adapur C.D. Block lies in the northern part of Purba Champaran district. The Block is located at a distance of 36 kms. from district headquarters (Motihari). There are 60 villages in the block with the total population of 156,354 persons. Area of the C.D. Block is 153.18 sq. kms. It is bounded by the international border of Indo-Nepal on north, C.D. Block Narkatia and Banjaria on south, C.D. Block Narkatia on east, C.D. Blocks Raxaul and Ramgarhwa on west. Headquarters: Adapur.
