

ABHANPUR

Abhanpur C.D. Block lies in the central part of Raipur district. It is a part of Abhanpur tehsil. The Block is located at a distance of (NA) kms. from district headquarters (Raipur). There are 104 villages in the block with the total population of 175,840 persons. Area of the C.D. Block is 589.76 sq. km. It is bounded by tahsils Raipur and Arang on north, district Dhamtari on south, tahsil Rajim on east, and district Durg on west.
