

ADITYAPUR

Adityapur (Gamharia) C.D. Block lies in the eastern part of Pashchimi Singhbhum district. It is a part of Adityapur Sub-district. The Block is located at a distance of 52 kms. from district headquarters (Chaibasa). There are 198 villages in the block with the total population of 101,645 persons. Area of the C.D. Block is 300.82 sq. kms. It is bounded by C.D. Block Chandil on north, C.D. Blocks Saraikela and Gobindpur on south, district Purba Singhbhum and C.D. Block Chandil on east, and C.D. Block Saraikela on west. Headquarters: Adityapur.
