

ADIMALI

Adimali C.D. Block lies in the northern part of Idukki district. It is a part of Devikulam and Udumbanchola tehsils. The Block is located at a distance of (NA) kms. from district headquarters (Painavu). There are 07 villages in the block with the total population of 185,861 persons. Area of the C.D. Block is 615.58 Sq. kms. It is bounded by taluk Kothamangalam (Ernakulam district) and C.D. Block Devikulam on north, taluk Thodupuzha on south, taluk Udumbanchola and C.D. Block Devikulam on east, and taluk Kothamangalam (Ernakulam district) on west. Headquarters: Mannamkandam.
