August Muni C.D. Block lies in the south-eastern part of Rudra Prayag district. It is a parts of Ukhimath and Rudra Prayag tehsils. The Block is located at a distance of (NA) kms. from district headquarters (Rudra Prayag). There are 398 villages in the block with the total population of 120, 411 persons. Area of the C.D. Block is 364.69sq. km. It is bounded by vikas khand Ukhimath on north, district Chamoli on east, district Garhwal on south-west, district Tehri Garhwal on west, and vikas khand Jakholi on north-west.
